

Hi everyone,

The demonstration scheduled for April 17th has been suspended after a settlement was reach with Securitas earlier today.

Following the announcement of a demonstration two weeks ago, STAS asked for a meeting to discuss the issue. A meeting with the Vice-President of Securitas took place and Michel Courcy our union staff rep and Richard Boudreault the Regionnal Coordinator for the United Steelworkers accompanied us.

The settlement approved earlier today by the Executive Committee contains 2 provisions to address the breaks issue:

- 1. The company agrees to submit the breaks issue to an arbitrator (May 8th). The union and the company will both explain their point of view on the issue to the arbitrator that will decide on the matter;
- 2. Permanent "rovers" system. In each checkpoint, 2 screeners will serve as rovers with the only duties to replace other screeners for "2 minutes" to allow their colleagues to drink water and access the sanitary installations.
